Mainland Uniforms Ph. 3603037 also stock **most items** of our school uniform.

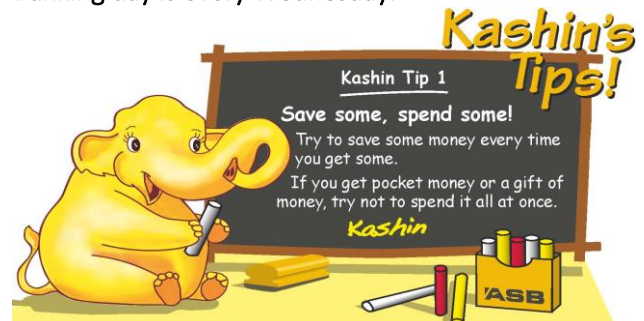
