REMINDERS...

- The yearly **Religious Education Levy of \$5 per child and the family photocopy fee of \$10 per family are now due for payment.** Please send this money to your child's classroom teacher in a named envelope.
- **Year 7 & 8 Technology Fees are due for payment \$70.00.** Please send this money to your child's classroom teacher in a named envelope.
- **THE WINTER SCHOOL UNIFORM IS WORN in TERM 2 and TERM 3**
- Please remind your children to wear their correct winter uniform to school everyday. That includes their school tie and school shoes.

Boys: Grey Winter Shorts and Shirts, School jersey, Tie, Plain long school socks and School Shoes

Girls: Pinafore, White Long Sleeve Blouse, School Jersey or School Cardigan, Tie, Navy over the knee socks or navy tights, School Shoes.

School Polar Fleece can be worn as an 'optional' extra as **part of the Winter Uniform only.** They are not to be worn in the classroom, but can be worn to and from school and in the playground when it is cold.

Children must wear their school jersey when it is cold. The polar fleece must not be worn in place of the school jersey.

Long Hair should be tied back and only blue and burgundy hair ties should be worn.

- Navy Blue Micro-fibre Track-pants (Style No. 99457) have been added to our School Sports Uniform Requirements at the Warehouse. These are optional and can be worn over the top of the navy sports shorts.
- Year 7 & 8 Girls' skirts are now also available from the Warehouse.

Our full uniform is available from the 'Warehouse' at Hornby Mall.

If the Warehouse does not have the item you require this can be ordered in by them and should only take about a week if there are stocks available. Any problems please let the school office know.

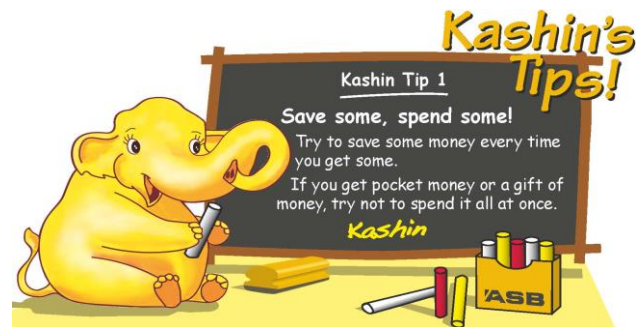
